01 The Hotel

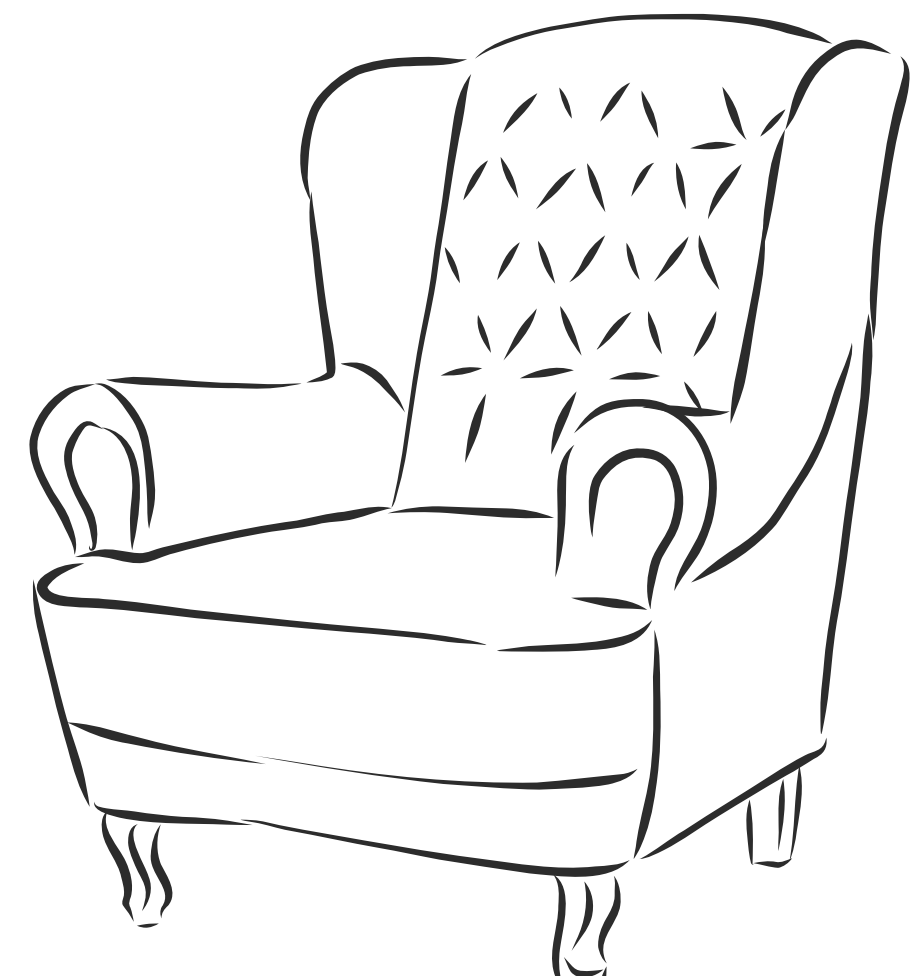

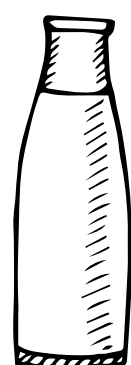
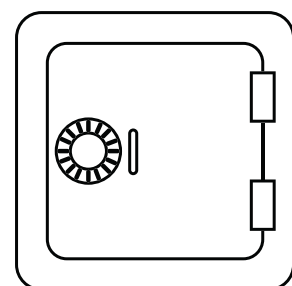

There is a safe in the closet in each room. Danger! The combination lock is out of order. The safe works with the key that is plugged in.

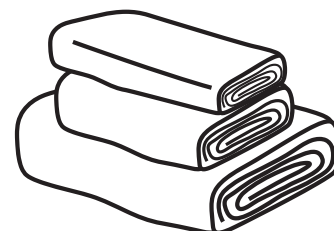


Our tap water is 100% drinking water quality - feel free to refill



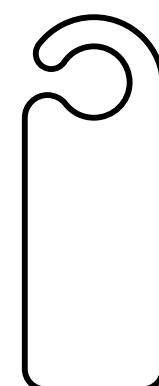
In some rooms you will find a tea station with organic teas. If you don't have a station but need one, please let us know

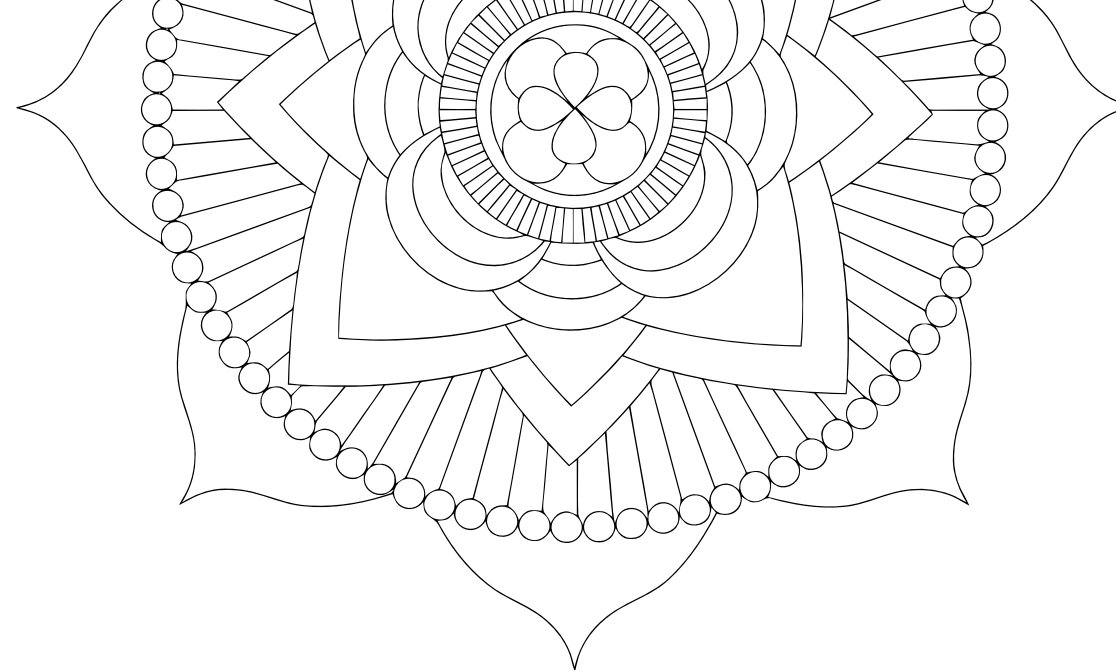

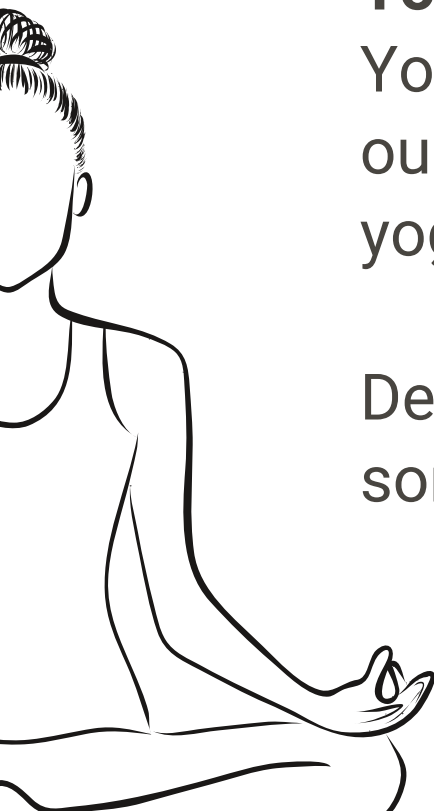
Massages

Yoga mats, blocks, belts and cushions are available in our yoga room. You are welcome to use it for your yoga practice or other sporting activities.

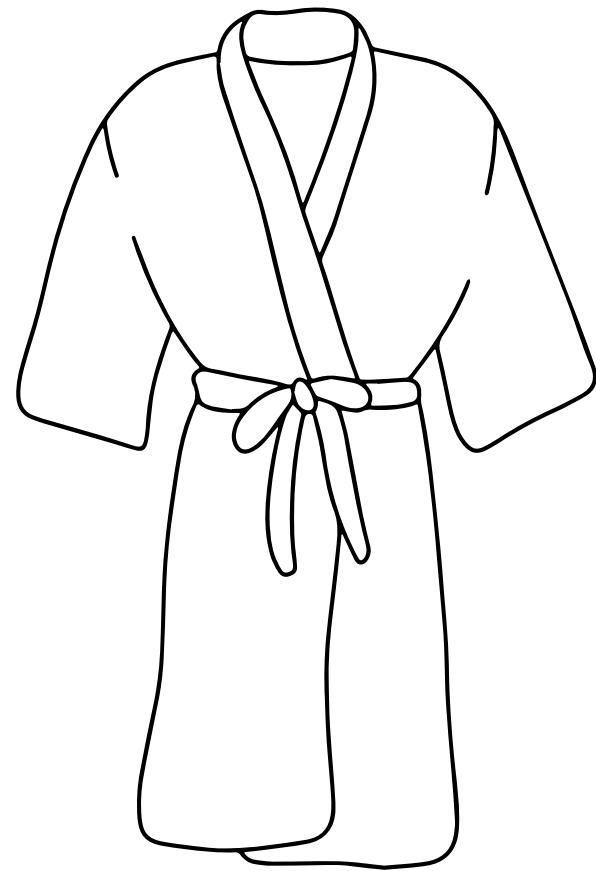
Depending on the occupancy, yoga classes are sometimes offered. Registration at the reception.

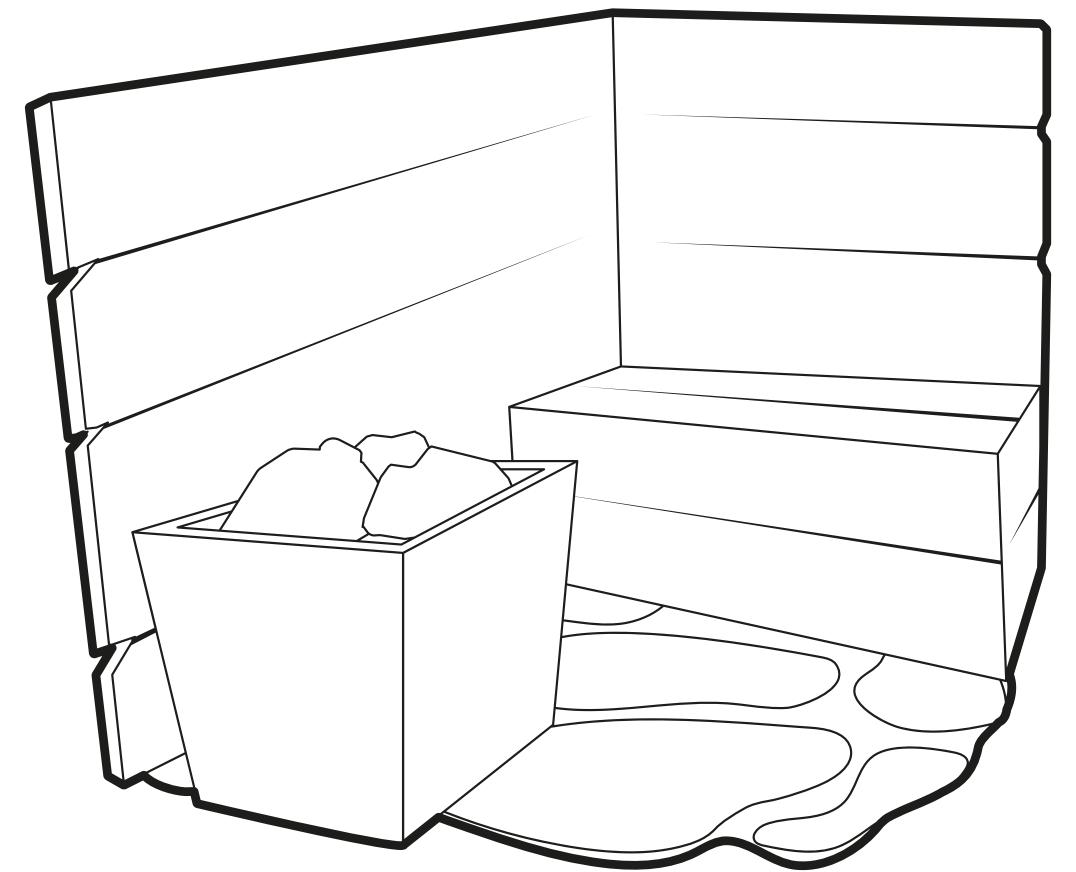


Private SPA with Finnish sauna and infrared

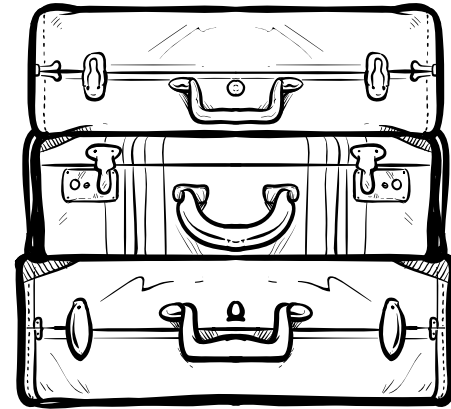

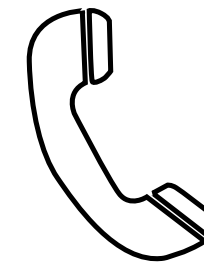
Lobby

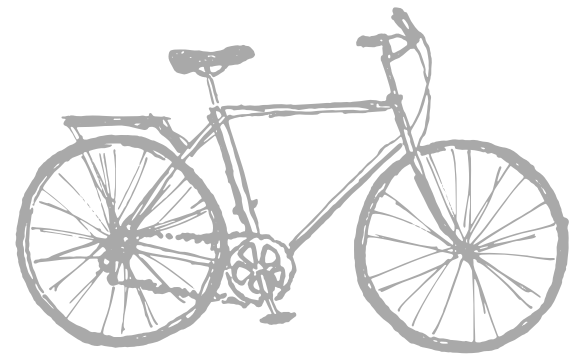

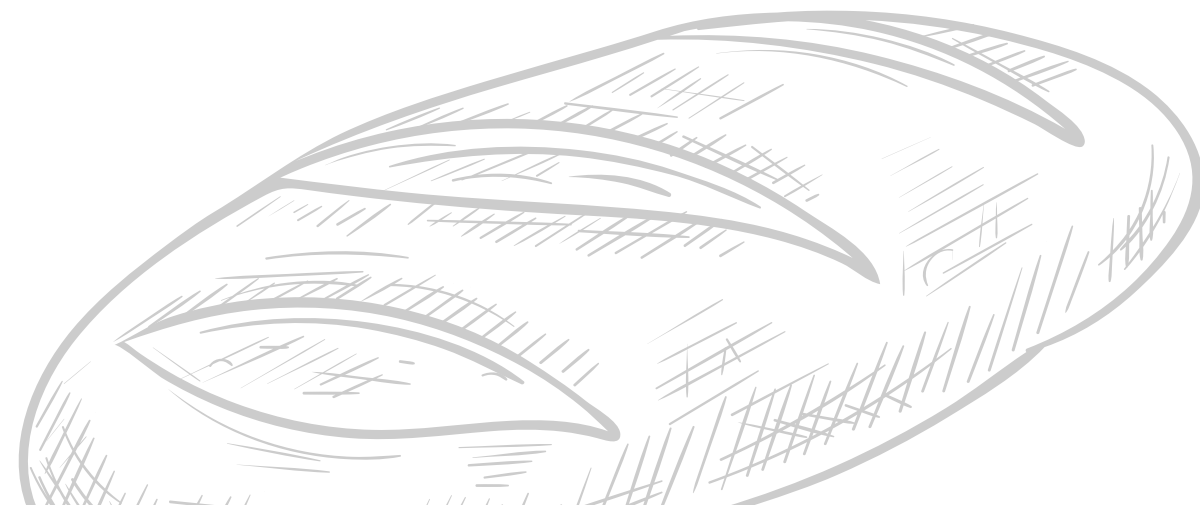
E-Bike Rental - Summer

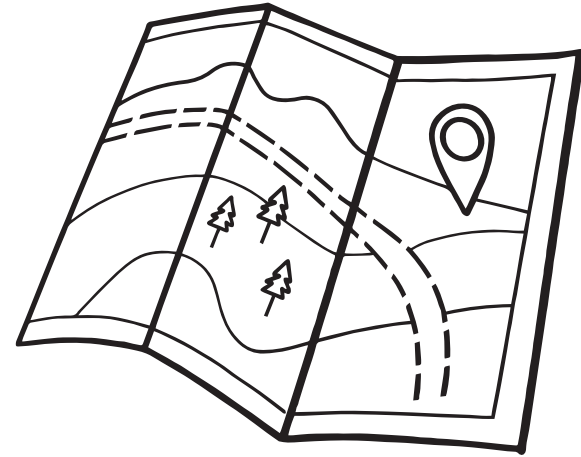

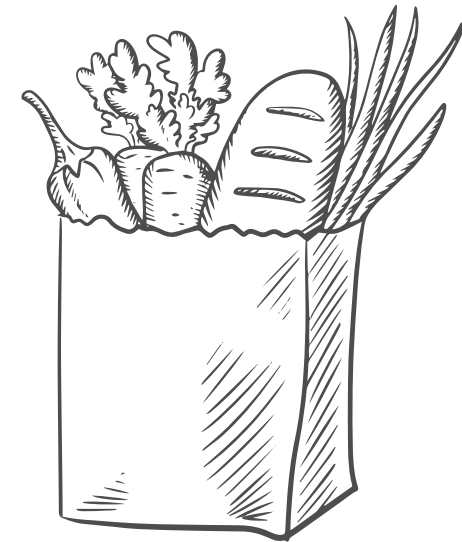
Shopping

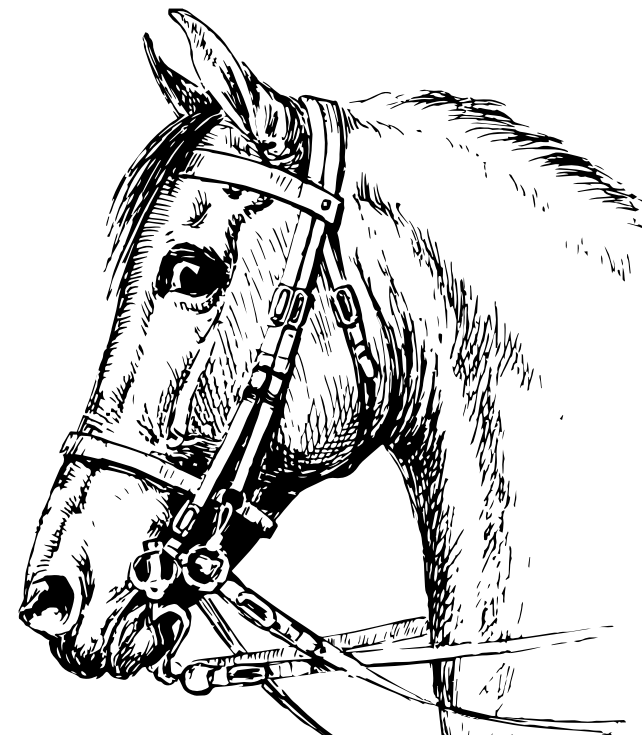

Visit the squirrels and ducks at Wildsee and bring them nuts

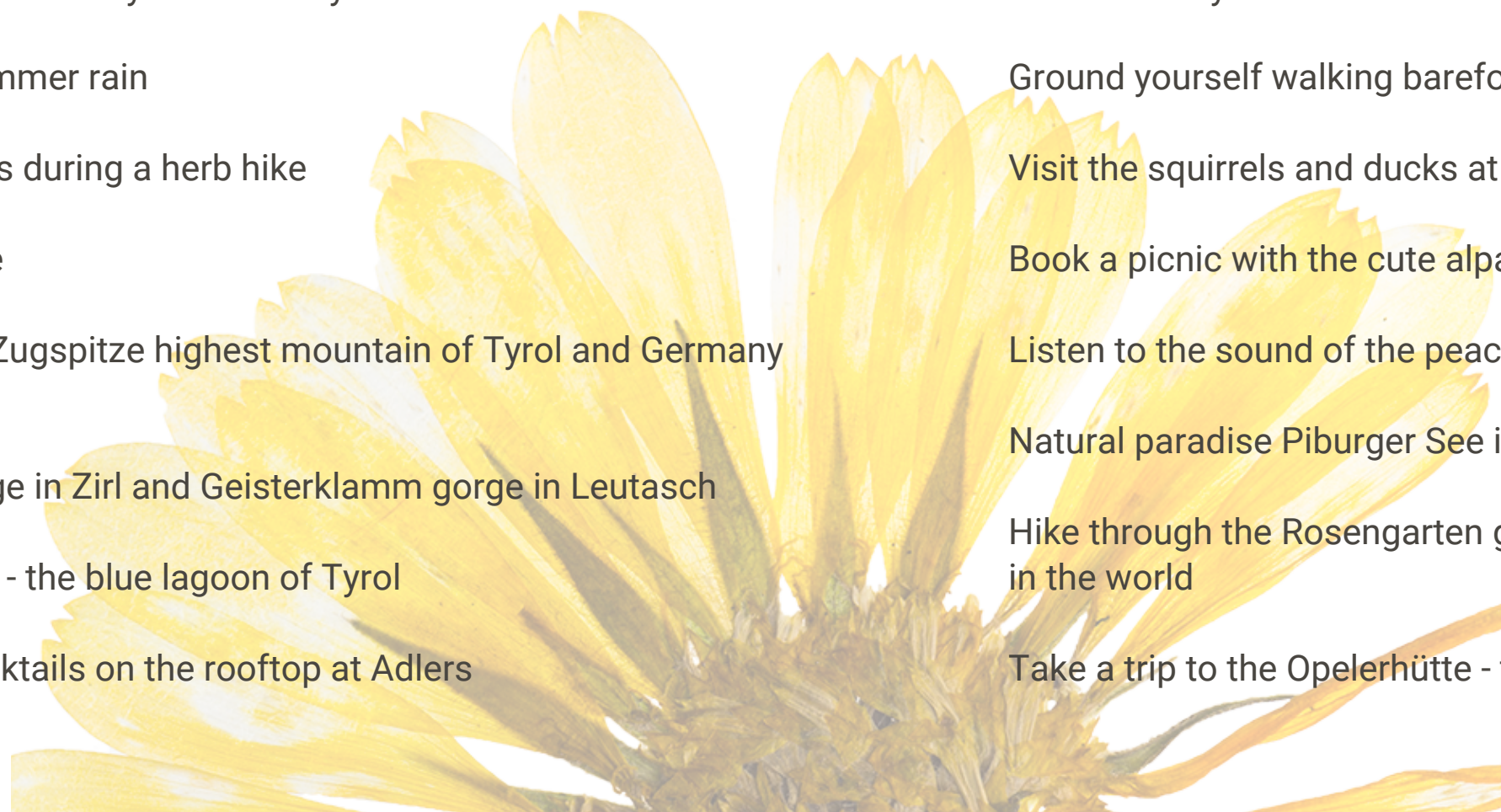
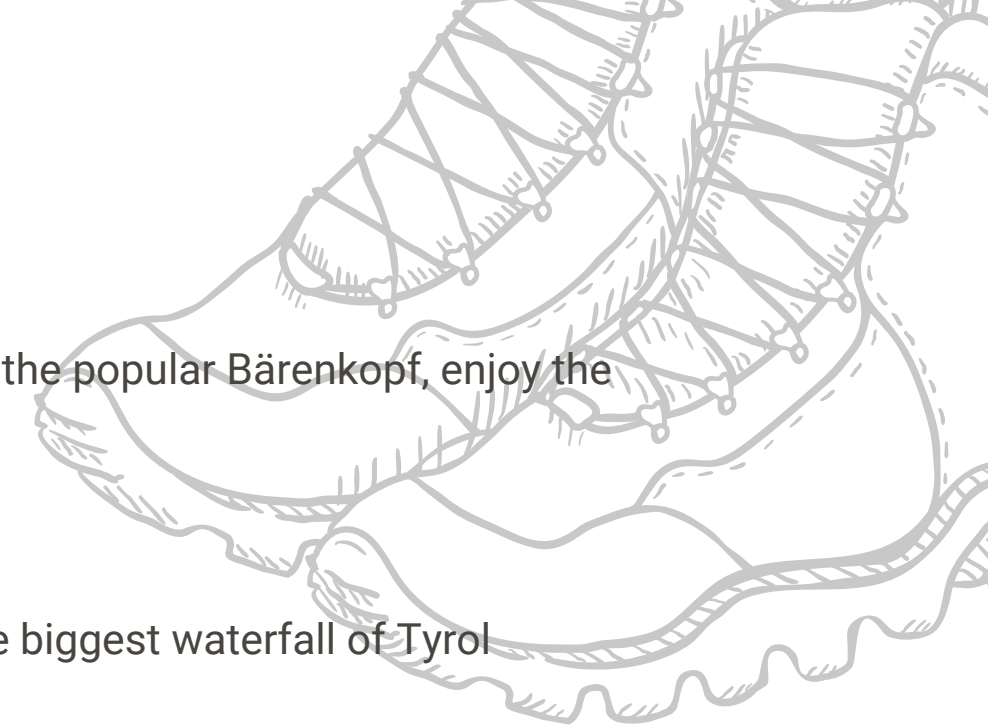
